Set Up a Web Admissions Account

Congratulations on deciding to go to college. Whatever your dreams are and whatever your background is, you are welcome here! As you complete this application, we want you to know that open doors -- and open minds -- await you.

Before you can complete an Application for Admission, you need to set up an account with the Web Admissions Center. Complete the steps below. Required information is indicated by an asterisk (*). When finished, click the Submit button.

- 1.* **Enter your name.** Type your first name, last name, and middle initial.

- 2.* **Create a user ID.**

Your user ID identifies you to the Web Admissions Center and allows you to access your application information at any time. Your user ID can be any combination of letters and numbers, but must contain a minimum of four (4) characters and a maximum of 16 characters. Spaces and special characters (!, @, #, and so forth) are not allowed. All letters are automatically converted to lower case. Examples of valid user IDs are *jsmith*, *katie12*, and *bobjones*. If you enter a user ID that has already been used, you will be prompted to create another one. Write down your user ID for future reference.

- 3.* **Create a password.**

Your password is used along with your user ID to verify your identity and to secure your application information so that only you can access it. Your password can be any combination of letters and numbers, but must contain a minimum of eight (8) characters and a maximum of 16 characters. You must include at least one number in your password. Spaces and special characters (!, @, #, and so forth) are not allowed. Do not use your user ID or your Social Security Number as your password. Examples of valid passwords are *newsho3s*, *12kitycats*, and *godawgs9*. Make sure you remember your password for future reference. You will not be able to access your application information without it.

Section 3 - Residency Information

Please read this notice before responding to the questions in this section:

Washington State law makes certain students, those who are not permanent residents or citizens of the United States, eligible for resident student status when they attend public colleges in the state. Resident students pay resident tuition rates and can apply for need-based state financial aid. These students are not eligible to receive need-based federal financial aid. To qualify for resident status, students must complete an affidavit/declaration/certification if they are not permanent residents or citizens of the United States but have met one of the following conditions:

Condition One:

- Resided in Washington State for three (3) years immediately prior to receiving a high school diploma, and
- Completed the full senior year at a Washington high school, and
- Continuously resided in the state since earning the high school diploma.

Condition Two:

- Completed the equivalent of a high school diploma, and
- Resided in Washington State for the three (3) years immediately before receiving the equivalent of the diploma, and
- Continuously resided in the State since earning the equivalent of a high school diploma.

If you meet one of these conditions and would like to pay resident tuition rates, you will need to print the affidavit from the link below, complete it, and mail it to the college or colleges you are applying to attend.
